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## LearnConnect 'Assessment Answer' Report

Hello and welcome to LearnConnect help.

### Purpose

This guide has been created to help you create a report in LearnConnect that shows you the answers submitted by users in an assessment.

### Audience

This guide is designed for anyone with Administrator privileges who has experience creating reports in LearnConnect.

### Supporting documents

Definitions of an extensive list of LearnConnect reporting terms can be found in the Custom Reports Glossary of Terms.

The Introduction to Reporting guide provides foundation knowledge for this document. If you are new to creating custom reports in LearnConnect it is strongly recommended that you refer to that guide before beginning this one. Additional reporting functionality, including the configuration of complex report filters, is covered in the Advanced Reporting guide.

## Creating an Assessment Answer report

This answer report is configured to display the answers that a learner has submitted to an assessment that was built using the Create Learning function. An assessment is also known as a 'Test' in LearnConnect.

### Filters

In this example we want to see the answers submitted in an assessment titled 'How to make a perfect coffee'. To narrow the report results to show results only for Test Names that contain the word 'perfect', in the Field drop-down we have selected **Test Name**, selected the Operator **contains**, and then typed **perfect** in the Value field. Enter a word from your chosen assessment to return valid results.
